SOPHOMORE REQUIREMENTS: (5 Credits required by the end of Freshman year to be on track for graduation.)

***English** – English II, ** Pre-AP English II, or English Mastery

***World History/Digitools** – 1 semester World History or **Honors Euro History/ 1 semester of Digitools
Digitools must be taken & passed before taking Culminating Project in Junior year..

*** Math** – Must complete 3 years- to include 1year Algebra I and 1 year Geometry.

Pass 2 math end-of-course assessments (algebra I & geometry) or state approved alternative.

*** Science/Tech.** – 3 years required. *Pass one science EOC in Biology or state approved alternative.*

*** Other:** Include any requirements not completed in 9th grade.

(This would be any required classes that were failed or required classes that were deferred for any reason.)

- Health/Fitness – 1 semester Health required (0.5 credits) 3 semesters Fitness required (1.5 credits)
- Fine Arts – 2 semesters required
- World Language – 2 years of same language required to attend a 4 year college

**Teacher permission is required for any classes so designated in the curriculum guide.
